

INTRODUCTION / IDENTIFICATION (3 lines)

- Type of graph: bar diagram, histogram, line graph, population pyramid, sector diagram, triangular diagram, etc.
- Title (fact represented)
- Author (if it is known) or source.
- Date or period of time (Ancient Age, Middle Ages, Modern Age, 8th century, 15th century, etc.)

DESCRIPTION (5-6 lines)

- Elements of the graph, taking into account the legend.
- Periods represented.
- General trend of the graph.
- Phases that can be specified.

ANALYSIS / COMMENTARY (8-10 lines)

- Explain the graph subject.
- Try to make relations between the graph and the historical/geographical context.

CONCLUSION (3 lines)

- The value of the graph to understand the geographical fact or the historical period indicated.
