INTRODUCTION / IDENTIFICATION (3 lines)

- \rightarrow Type of map: physical, historical, political, economic, demographic or cultural.
- \rightarrow Location: geographical boundaries.
- \rightarrow Title (fact represented)
- \rightarrow Author (if it is known) or source.

 \rightarrow Date or period of time (Ancient Age, Middle Ages, Modern Age, 8th century, 15th century, etc.)

DESCRIPTION (5-6 lines)

 \rightarrow Describe the historical map or the geographical aspect represented. You should follow the legend and point the scale.

 \rightarrow Symbols and elements: describe their meaning and identify them in the current location of the countries shown.

ANALYSIS / COMMENTARY (8-10 lines)

- \rightarrow Explain the map subject.
- \rightarrow Try to make relations between the map and the historical/geographical context.

CONCLUSION (3 lines)

 \rightarrow The value of the map to understand the fact or the historical period indicated.
